Introduction

What is the **West Gate Tunnel?**

What's new?

The West Gate Tunnel is a new road connecting Melbourne's west with the Port of Melbourne and broader freeway network to keep freight moving 24/7. You will be able to use it to travel from the west to the city and back again.
















There will be a single toll point for heavy vehicles between Millers Road and Williamstown Road to use the upgraded freeway, Hyde Street ramps, new tunnels and

New no-truck zones




When the West Gate Tunnel opens, six inner west roads will have 24-hour no-truck zones.

This will cover Francis Street and Somerville Road in Yarraville, Buckley Street and Moore Street in Footscray, Blackshaws Road in Altona North, and Hudsons Road in Spotswood. A night-time and weekend no-truck zone will also be in place on Williamstown Road (8pm - 6am weekdays and at all times on weekends).

Roadside cameras will help monitor and enforce the no-truck zones. Exceptions will apply for trucks with local origins and destinations within the zones for local deliveries, construction or maintenance works, and other situations as prescribed in the No-Truck Zone regulations. Visit transport.vic.gov.au/no-truck-zones for more information.

Remember

Trucks over 68.5T can't travel over the West Gate Bridge or the Bolte Bridge. This applies to both directions.





There are separated traffic lanes to help motorists get to where they want to go including:

- Left-hand lanes for getting into the tunnel (citybound) or off the freeway at Grieve Parade, Millers Road and Williamstown Road, and to get to Hyde Street (citybound).
- Right-hand express lanes to continue over the West Gate Bridge (citybound) or continue through to the Princes Freeway and M80 Ring Road (westbound).

New entry and exit ramps at Hyde Street

Entry ramp for westbound travel and citybound exit ramp to access Port of Melbourne for heavy vehicles that can't travel through the tunnels or are heading to local industry.



New exit ramps at MacKenzie Road and Appleton Dock Road

For direct access to the Port of Melbourne.



New entry points to access West Gate Tunnel

Coming from the city you'll need to use Dynon Road in West Melbourne, Wurundjeri Way or Footscray Road in Docklands, or CityLink to get to the tunnel.

Common heavy vehicle journeys of the West Gate Tunnel

This section is broken down into heading into and out of the city.

Plan your route towards the city

You'll have a choice between the West Gate Tunnel or the Hyde Street ramps to get to the Port of Melbourne.

Step 1:

Choose your lane early when travelling from the M80 Ring Road or Princes Freeway



Left for West Gate Tunnel and freeway exits

Take the left lanes and follow the signs for West Gate Tunnel or getting off the freeway at Millers Road, Williamstown Road, and the new Hyde Street exit ramp.



Right for express lanes to West Gate Bridge

Keep right for the express lanes and follow signs to head to City South and south-eastern suburbs over the West Gate Bridge.



Exiting the freeway at Hyde Street?

Follow the signs and take the right lane once you've passed the Williamstown Road exit to get to Hyde Street. This ramp exit is for port and local industry access, and oversize and placarded loads because these kinds of loads can't use the tunnel



Step 2: Entering the West Gate Tunnel

Choose your new options to exit and enter the freeway network

Follow signs and enter the West Gate Tunnel from the West Gate Freeway near Williamstown Road.



Step 3: Choose your final destinations



Continuing onto CityLink and Melbourne Airport

Once you exit the tunnel, stay in the centre lanes. Follow the signs for 'M2 CityLink' to travel onto



To get to the Port of Melbourne

After exiting the tunnel, follow the signs for MacKenzie Road, or Appleton Dock Road.

Key journeys

Plan your route outbound towards Ballarat/Geelong

The West Gate Tunnel will give you more options for travel between the port and the regional centres.

Step 1: Choose your starting point

From Appleton Dock Road:

- Turn left onto Footscray Road.
- Stay in the left lane and follow signs for 'M4 Geelong'.
- Continue up the ramp to the West Gate Tunnel.



From MacKenzie Road:

- Follow the signs and lane markings for 'M4 Geelong'.
- Continue through to the West Gate Tunnel.

From Hyde Street:

- This new ramp will provide express access to the West Gate Freeway from Simcock Avenue.
- Depending on which way you're travelling along Hyde Street, follow the signs for the West Gate Freeway and 'M1 Geelong'.





Step 2: Once you're on the West Gate Freeway, pick your lanes for travel towards Geelong or Ballarat

Travelling from the West Gate Tunnel

Choose your lane early



Left lanes towards M1 Princes Freeway (Geelong).



Right lanes towards M80 Ring Road (Ballarat/Bendigo).

Travelling from the West Gate Bridge

Choose your lane early

Once you're over the bridge, take the right-hand express lanes and follow the signs for 'M1 Geelong'

Then once you pass Millers Road, you'll need to stay in:



The **left lanes** to get to the M80 Ring Road (Ballarat-bound).



The **right lanes** for the Princes Freeway (Geelong-bound).



All heavy vehicles will pay a single toll on West Gate Freeway located between Williamstown Road and Millers Road, no matter if you use the tunnel, the West Gate Bridge, or the Hyde Street ramps. **Toll Prices**

Heavy commercial vehicles (HCV)

HCV's are rigid trucks with three or more axles, or over 4.5T gross vehicle mass; buses; and articulated trucks.

Long heavy commercial vehicles (LHCV)

Long Heavy Commercial Vehicle (LHCV) is a new vehicle and tolling class which will apply to the new West Gate Tunnel, and the new tolled section of the West Gate Freeway.

LHCVs are heavy vehicles 26m in length or more.

Value for heavy vehicles

Tolling discounts and trip caps will help make the upgraded freeway and new tunnels more cost-effective for heavy vehicles.

Night-time travel	Trucks travelling at night (between 8pm and 6am) receive a 33% discount	
Multi-road toll cap	Trucks travelling on both CityLink and the West Gate Tunnel will have tolls for single trips capped at certain amounts depending on the time of day and vehicle class.	
West Gate Tunnel multi-trip discount	Heavy vehicles travelling back and forth all day will receive tolling discounts after the fourth trip:	
	First 4 trips:	trucks pay full toll
	Trips 5 to 8:	trucks pay 50% of toll
	Trips 9 and above:	no further charges

There are different ways you can pay for tolls

Businesses with fleets can set up commercial tolling accounts, with advanced features designed to help track toll charges. Visit **linkt.com.au** for more information.

If you travel on a toll road without an account

If you don't have an active tolling account when travelling through the West Gate Tunnel, you may receive a toll invoice and get charged additional fees and charges on top of the tolls. It's important to have an active tolling account or once-off pass, so it's easier for you to manage your travel, payments, and vehicles.

Transurban will operate the West Gate Tunnel when it opens. Find out more on their website.

Safety

Road safety and the West Gate Tunnel

Restrictions for placarded vehicles and dangerous goods.

Placarded vehicles, which transport dangerous goods, can't travel in the West Gate Tunnel. These loads must travel via the Hyde Street ramps. Go to page 7 for more information.

To ensure safety, avoid tunnels when carrying dangerous goods. An emergency exit for placarded loads is available near the tunnel entrance.

Looking out for you on the road

Cameras monitor traffic conditions on the West Gate Tunnel and CityLink 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

If you break down or have an incident, stay in your vehicle, turn hazard lights on and an incident response team will be sent out right away.

Save this!

If you're in an incident and need some help, Transurban's team are on the ready.

A red X means the lane is closed. There may be road works, a breakdown or debris on the road ahead. Speed limit signs change in response to incidents or congestion on the road. Motorists must follow the speed limit displayed on these signs.

When an incident occurs, arrows which tell you the lane to move in to.
These arrows may direct you to exit the freeway if necessary.

If you see this circle sign in the tunnel, proceed with caution as there may be an incident ahead.
